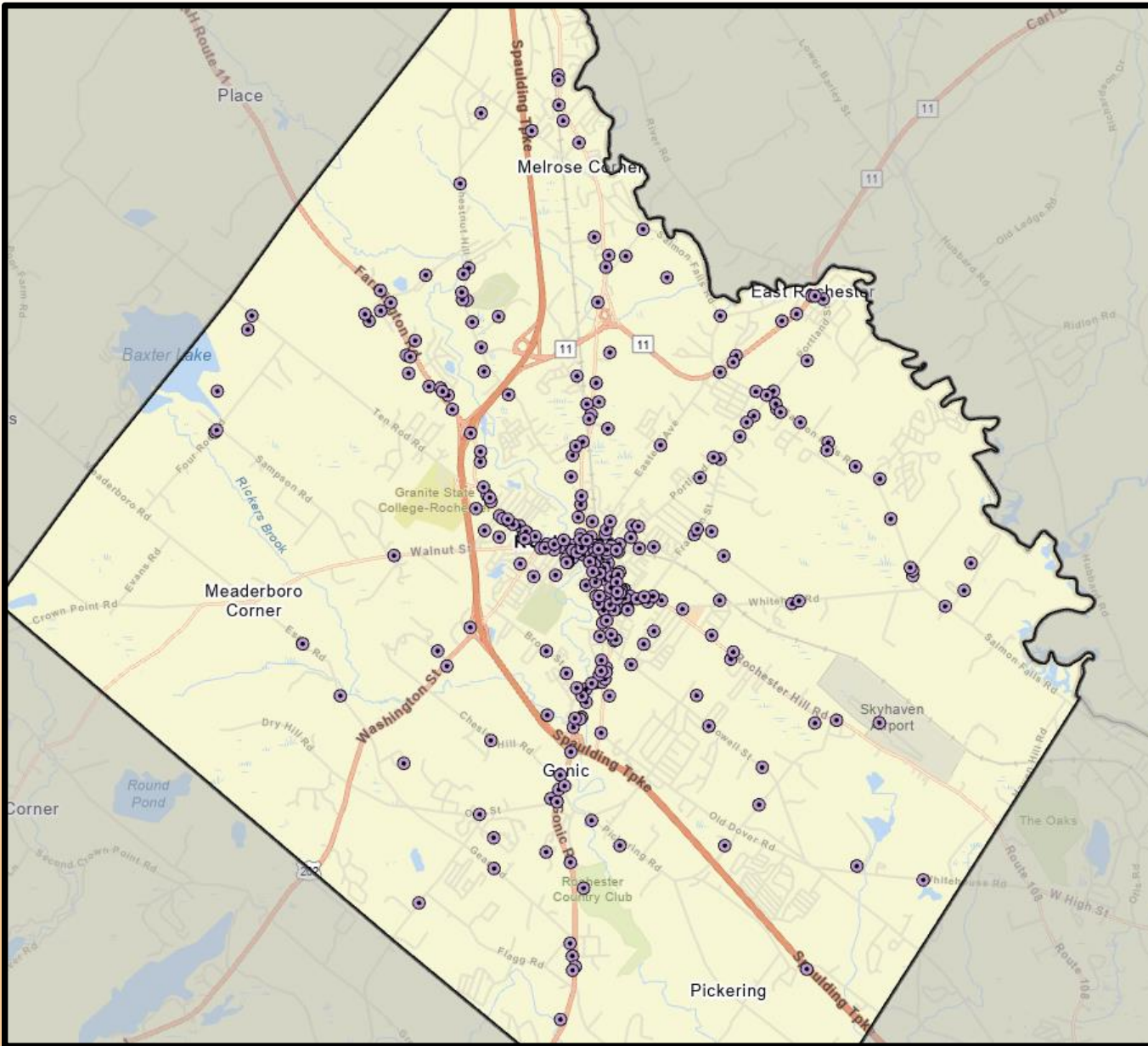

High Volume Roads

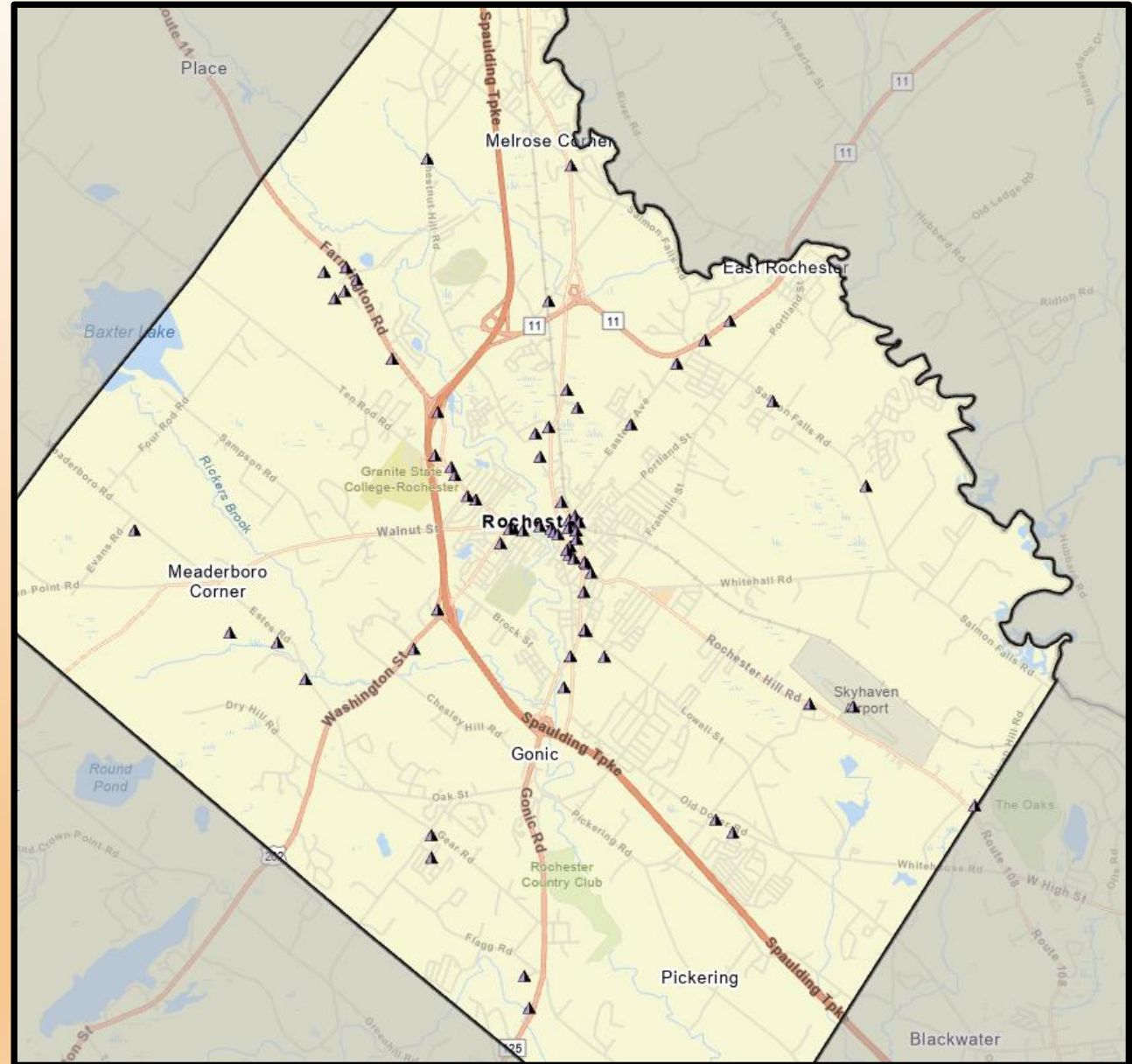

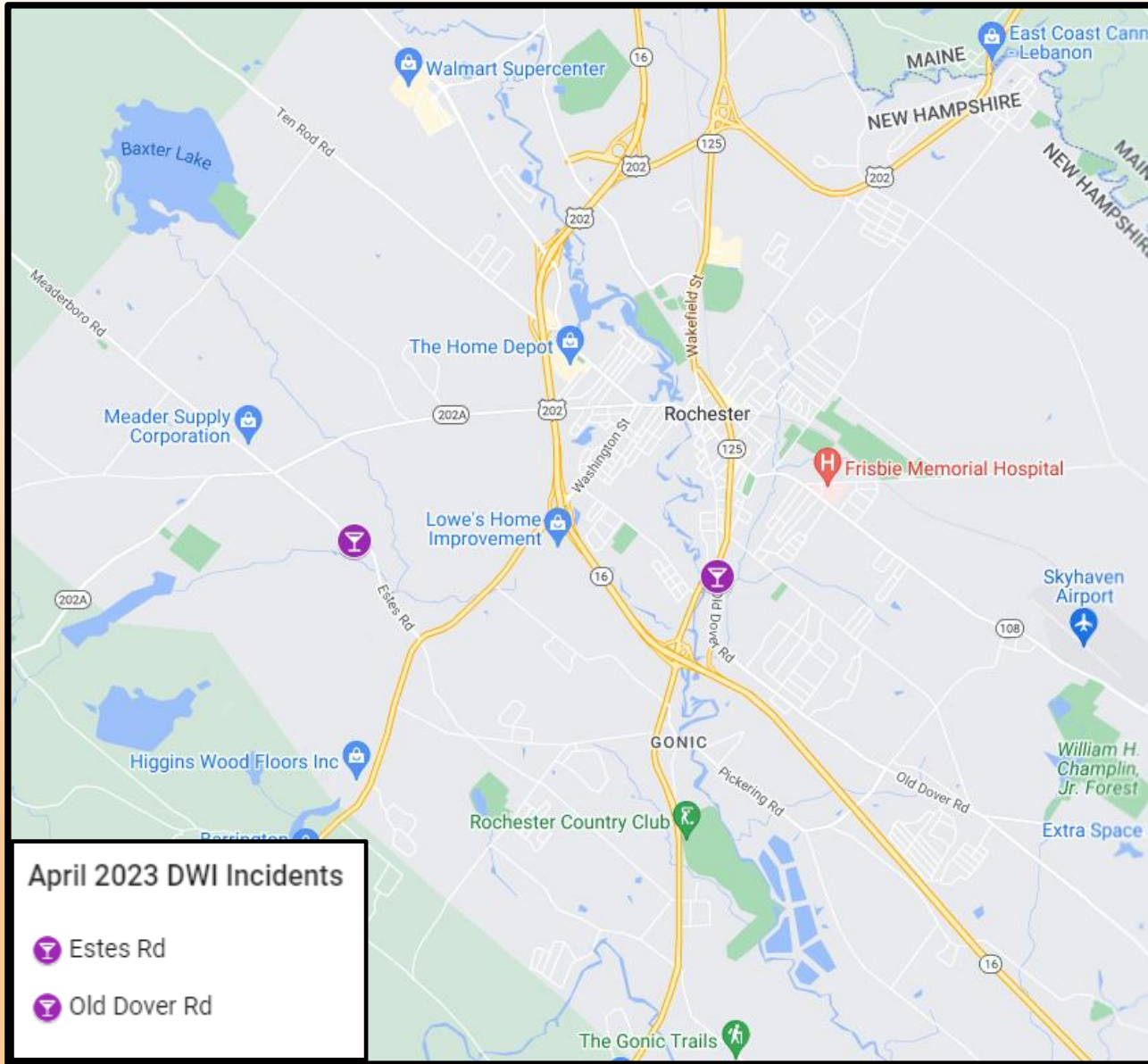

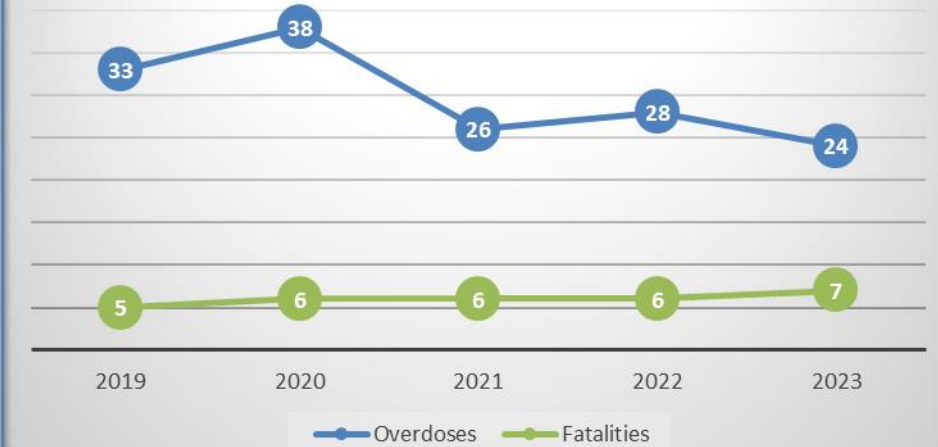

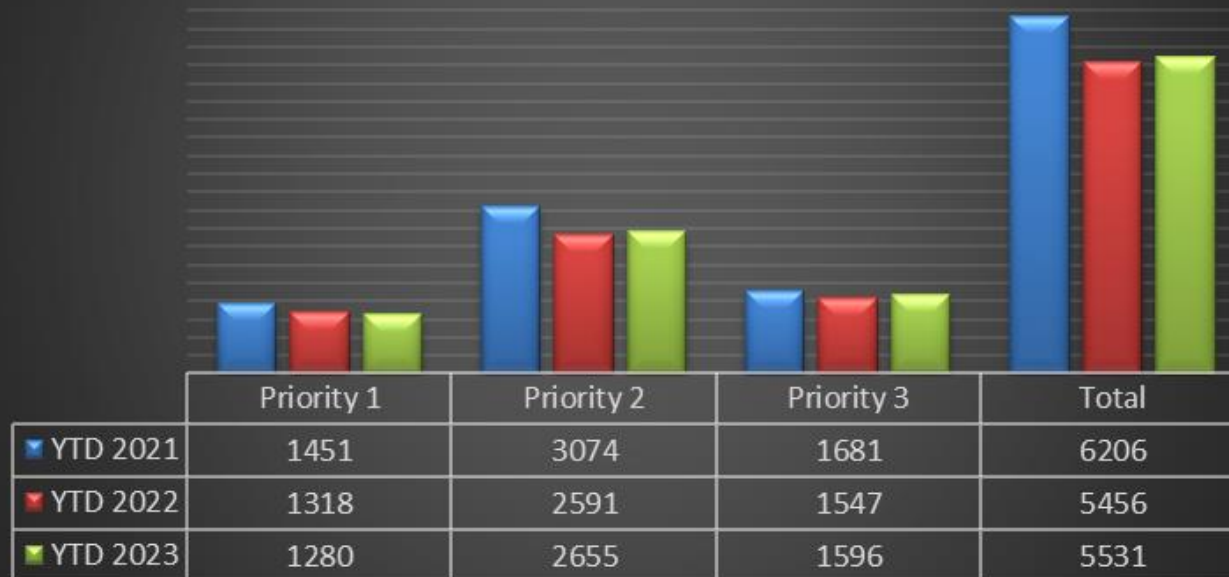

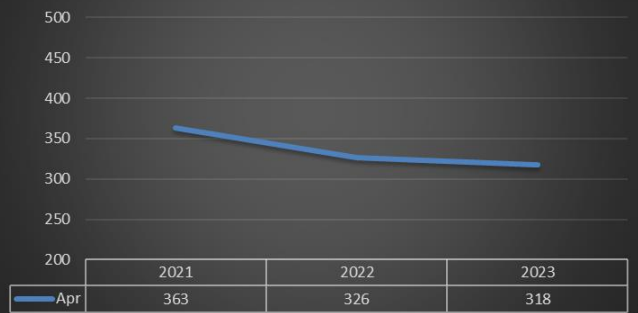

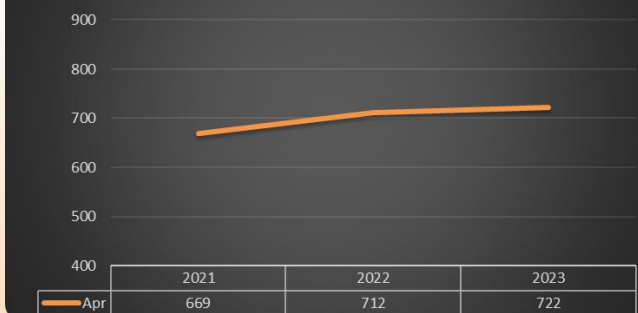


Calls for Service 3 Year Trend by Priority

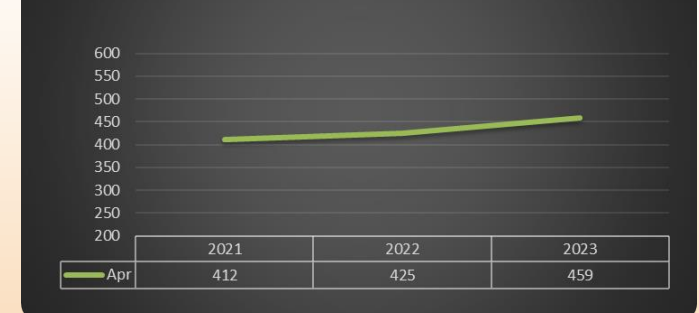

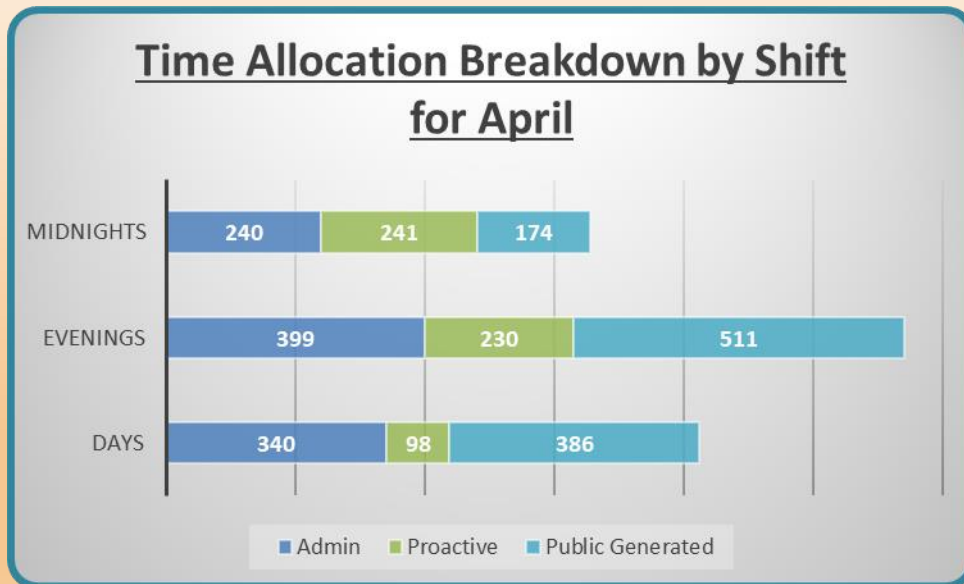
